Point of Care Testing – EPIC Go-Live

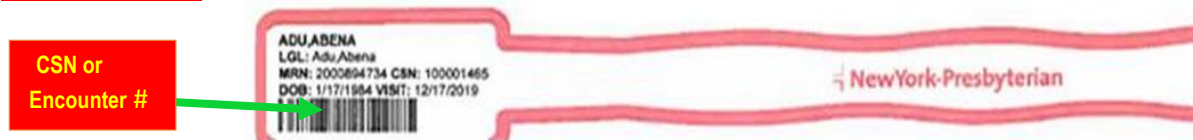
THE STANDARDIZATION OF THE PATIENT IDENTIFICATION # USED FOR POINT OF CARE TESTING

NOTE: Effective Epic cutover on 2-1-2020, the patient identifier used for point of care testing will be standardized to the **ENCOUNTER, FINANCIAL or CSN #**.

- ◆ The ENCOUNTER, FINANCIAL or CSN # can be found in the red rectangle of the patient's wristband, and on the individual patient labels.

Accu-Chek Glucose Testing

- For location where patients wear a wristband, scan the barcode located in the **red rectangle** on the new patient wristband for the Encounter or CSN #.



- For location where patients do not wear a wristband, scan the barcode on the individual labels for the Encounter or CSN #.



For All other Point of Care Tests (Example: blood gases, ACT, urinalysis)

- Label the collected sample using one of the patient's wristband page labels.
 - Scan the barcode on the label for the Encounter or CSN #.
