



ALLNYC EM RESIDENT EDUCATION FELLOWSHIP

We are excited to offer this fellowship to rising senior residents. The program is designed to provide experience in conference development, networking, and mentorship by the educational leaders within this group. This is a 1-year fellowship and will include costs to attend the 2021 virtual CORD academic assembly.

ALLNYCEM provides two citywide conferences per year. Additionally, we offer two “Medical Student Boot-camps,” and an EM chief resident retreat. Fellows in this program will gain experience in the content development, logistics, and finances required to put together these events. Attendance and participation will be expected, and each fellow will have the opportunity to give a lecture at one of the citywide ALLNYCEM conferences. Mentorship and networking will be an invaluable part of the fellowship. In addition to quarterly meetings with the fellowship directors, fellows will attend meetings with many of the regions residency leaders throughout the year, will facilitate collaboration amongst the chief residents of ALLNYCEM programs, and will have the opportunity to give an invited lecture to Wednesday morning conference at an ALLNYC participating program.

Fellows will gain experience that will help prepare them for an exciting academic career. We are seeking energetic and bright residents to join our team.

Eligibility Requirements

- Residents graduating in June 2022 (i.e. PGY-2 in a 3-year program or PGY-3 in a 4-year program)
- Residents from a program that actively participates in ALLNYCEM events
- Available to attend CORD academic assembly

- Personal statement (No more than 1 page) which addresses academic interests and career goals
- Letter of recommendation from your program director or chairman
- Updated CV
